**Parent sessions:**

Sarah has talked to Darren Underhill and Jen Kerslake about a program she is calling 'Substance Smart, Know to Say No.'. She has invited Jim Laidlaw, anti-smoking advocate, who may do an anti-smoking, anti-vaping, and anti-cannabis talk. She has also talked to Darren Underhill and Angela Lawrence, our district drug counsellor, to do anti-drug talk. It has been suggested to separate kids and parents and have a target age. Also, they would prefer to do outside of the gym. The plan would be to have the kids do the anti-smoking and the parents do the anti-drug and then they would switch. Everybody could then meet in the gym to wrap up with a discussion about how important support is. It takes a community. Sarah is just waiting to hear back from some people. We could probably use the library and the kindergarten room. It would be a good idea to add a fundraiser such as the grade 6 kids doing a supper to encourage people to attend. This talk would be aimed at grade 4 and up. This would probably be in April and we would like to have child care for the younger children.
